<u>Responsibilities:</u>	 Answering the 24-hour Hotline. Taking responsibility for the day to day operations of the 24-hour Shelter, including overseeing the Shelter during your shift. Providing other direct services for battered women. Interacting with the public. Other responsibilities, as needed.
<u>Hours / Schedule</u> :	Alternating Schedule: Sunday–Thursday or Tuesday–Saturday. Includes evenings.
<u>Qualifications</u> :	 Ability to perform all responsibilities listed. Sensitivity to the issue of domestic violence; work with diverse groups; work under pressure; hardworking; honest; reliable; friendly; and respectful. Ability to work a flexible schedule, including evening and weekend shifts. Must be able to bend, stoop, and do medium lifting and carrying; and be able to physically perform the basic life operational functions of climbing, reaching, standing, walking, lifting, fingering, grasping, talking and hearing. Must be able to independently operate a motor vehicle and possess a valid Driver's License. Must have reliable transportation. Experience in working with battered women not required. Intensive on-the-job training.
